In 2023 4-H members competing in the Storyboard will not be given a design brief, but instead will have the opportunity to find their own inspiration and direction for their design. 4-H members should create their original design and Storyboard based on something that personally inspires them. Designer’s Choice (The title for each storyboard will be determined by the designer)

The contest is being planned and organized by the District 4-H Storyboard Committee. District 3 Fashion Storyboards will be judged prior to Fashion Show; awards will be announced at Fashion Show.

1. **EVENT DATE:** 4-H Online will open January 1st- March 17th and participants must have entries submitted on 4-H Online by midnight on March 17th, 2023.
2. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** NO LATE registration
3. **ENTRY FEE:** \$10.00 on 4-H Online
4. **AGE DIVISION:** Junior- 8 years old and in the 3rd - 5th grades; Intermediate- 6th - 8th grades; Senior- 9th-12th grades
5. **PLACING:** Only the Top 5 placings in each category in each age division will be assigned a ranking.
6. **PLEASE NOTE:** Storyboards is an invitational contest at the senior 4-H level. A 4-H member may enter only one storyboard.
7. **All State Storyboard Guidelines will be used except for participation age, entry fee, entry deadline and awards.**
8. **All entries are digital on 4H Connect, Juniors & Intermediates are allowed to take a picture of their Storyboard and submit picture for entry; make sure to follow guidelines on size.**
